they glorified God; and they were filled with fear, saying, We have seen glorious things today.

- 27 And after these things He departed, and saw a publican named Levi sitting at the receipt of custom, and He said to him, Follow Me.
- 28 And he forsook all things, stood^up, and followed Him.
- 29 And Levi made a great reception for Him in his house; and there was a crowd of many publicans and of others who were sitting "down with them.
- 30 And their scribes and the Pharisees murmured against His disciples, saying, Why do you eat and drink with publicans and sinners?
- 31 And Jesus answering said to them, They who are well have no need of a physician, but they who are ill.
- 32 I came not to call the just, but sinners to repentance.
- 33 And° they said to Him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise *the disciples* of the Pharisees, but° Thine eat and drink?
- 34 And He said to them, Can you make the sons of the bride-chamber fast, while the Bridegroom is with them?
- 35 But° the days will come when the Bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days.

- 36 And° He spoke also a parable to them: No one puts a piece of a new garment upon an old garment; otherwise both the new rips it_{*}^{26} and the piece from the new agrees not with the old.
- 37 And no one puts young wine into old bottles²⁷; otherwise the young wine will burst the bottles and be spilled, and the bottles will perish.
- 38 But young wine must be put into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- 39 And no one, having drunk old wine, straightway desires young, for he says, The old is more agreeable.

CHAPTER 6

AND° it came to pass on the second first Sabbath, that He went through the grain°; and His disciples plucked the ears of grain, and did eat, rubbing them with their hands.

- 2 And certain of the Pharisees said to them, Why do you do what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath *days*²⁸?
- 3 And Jesus answering said to them, Have you not read this which David did, when he hungered, he and they who were with him;
- 4 how he went into the house of God, and took the shewbread, and ate, and
